## CODE OF ORDINANCES City of Wyandotte

#### **Sec.4042. required**

It shall be unlawful for any person to own, maintain, keep or harbor a dog, cat or ferret without a license for such animal issued by the City (Ord. No. 1119 § 2, 6-11-01)

#### **Sec. 4043. Application**

Application for a license shall be made to the animal control officer, police department Records Bureau, City Clerk or to any licensed veterinarian having a business establishment within the City and shall state the breed, sex, age, color and marking of the animal and the name and address of the applicant. The application shall be accompanied by a certificate of a licensed veterinarian showing that the animal has been vaccinated against rabies. Any application made to the City clerk or to any licensed veterinarian as described herein shall be forthwith forwarded to the Wyandotte Police Department for retention and reference information.

#### **Sec. 4-44. Expiration**

Animal licenses shall be issued for a one-year, two-year or three – year period, commencing January 1 and expiring December 31 to correspond with the rabies vaccination expiration date.
