General Scope of Work consists of cold milling, concrete base repair, drainage structure improvements, HMA base repair, HMA wearing surface, and restoration on 19th Street from Eureka to Pine Street. Also, concrete pavement repair, structure improvements, and restoration on 8th Street from Grove to Marshall, all per Plans and Specifications copies obtained through the Michigan Inter-governmental Trade Network (MITN) website at www.mitn.info.
